In the Preamble to the Charter of the UN, the objectives of the UN stand enshrined. The objectives are:

- (1) To save the succeeding generations from scourge of war.
- (2) To maintain faith in fundamental human rights, in the work and dignity of human person and equal rights of men, ~~and~~ women and nations, large and small.
- (3) To establish conditions under which justice and respect for the obligations arising from treaties can be maintained.
- (4) To promote social progress and better standard of life.

- (1) To maintain international peace and security and to achieve this end to take effective collective measures for the prevention and removal of threat to peace.
