

08 Conditions for the expression and formation  
09 of sound public opinion -

10 (1) For the formation of sound public  
11 opinion, the first necessity is  
12 educating the people so that they  
13 may be able to understand politics  
14 well.

15 (2) The system of education should be  
16 such that there should be no  
17 narrow-mindedness and people  
18 should become broad-minded.

19 (3) The press should not be under  
20 control of a particular party.  
21 It should guide the government  
22 and the people impartially.

23 (4) The government should banish  
24 communism and poverty from the  
25 country so that everybody should  
26 have the opportunity to receive  
27 education and be able to think  
28 with an open mind.

29 (5) The political parties should be organised  
30 accordingly economic and political principles.  
31 They should not be organised on the  
32 basis of religious principles.
