

08 Differences between Non-Alignment
09 and Neutrality

10 The western scholars like Hans J.
11 Morgenthau, George Lisaka and
12 Lawrence W. Morton have preferred
the term 'neutrality' to
'non-alignment'. But there is
a difference between the two:

13 1- Non-Alignment is a policy of
14 keeping out alliances in general
and military pacts in particular
while political neutrality means
15 keeping away from particular
issue. A non-aligned need not
16 to be neutral under all
circumstances. Under exceptional
17 circumstances, it may participate
actively in world affairs.

18 2- A neutral country will be
19 neutral towards both aggressive
countries but non-alignment
20 country will support that
country which is on just.

3- The policy of neutrality is of
aloofness from the world politics
but the policy of non-alignment
will be helpful in making the
future better of third world countries.
