Right to Equality - The purpose of this right is to establish the rule of law where all the citizens should be treated equal before law. It has 5 provisions (Articles 14-18)

- (1) Equality before law
- (2) No discrimination on the basis of Religion, Race, Caste, Sex or Place of Birth
- (3) Equality of opportunity to all citizens in matter of Public Employment

- (4) Abolition of Untouchability
- (5) Abolition of Titles
