Objectives of the Constitution

- (3) Equality
- (4) Fraternity

The objectives as stated in the Preamble are: Justice; Social, economic, and political; Liberty of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship; Equality of Status and of Opportunity; Fraternity assuring the dignity of the individual and unity and integrity of the Nation.
