

Characteristics of Behaviourism as given by Heinz
Eulau

- 1- It concentrates on the theoretical and empirical analysis of the behaviour of persons and social groups rather than on the origin of the State, functions of the Government and political institutions like the traditionalists.
- 2- It tries to integrate theory and research in relation to social psychology, sociology and cultural anthropology.
- 3- It emphasises the interdependence of the theory and research. Theoretical questions should be studied from the empirical point of view and the empirical research should be applied to theoretical questions.
- 4- It tries to develop rigorous empirical research methodology and it applies this methodology to the political problems arising out of the behaviour of the individuals.
