

Failure of Behaviouralism and Rise of Post-Behaviouralism

While behaviouralism was a movement against traditionalism, the post-behaviouralism was also a movement against behaviouralism itself but instead of condemning either of the two methods of thought, it was a synthesis between the two contending schools of thought. Behaviouralism was not a new discipline, rather it was just a new technique, a new approach, with a new focus in view for the study of political science. The traditional approaches such as philosophical, historical and institutional did not worry about human behaviour or group-behaviour and neglected the scientific analysis of the human problems. Therefore, the people first found that it failed to solve any problem such as threat of nuclear war, hunger, poverty, disease etc. So, the Post-Behaviouralism rose against it.
